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## WELCOME TO THE WORLD OF CRYSTAL

It all begins with a single grain of sand, the basic ingredient in glassmaking, eventually turning into works of inexpressible beauty. The world-renowned Moser manufactory represents the pinnacle of Czech glassmaking tradition.



#### LUDWIG MOSER, FOUNDER

Ludwig Moser was born in 1833 in the spa town of Karlovy Vary. He apprenticed under the exceptional local glass engraver, Anton Heinrich Mattoni. He also gained trade and commercial experience in Vienna, Prague, and Berlin.

#### 1857

At the age of 24, he opened his own engraving workshop and glass shop in the centre of Karlovy Vary.

#### 1893

He had his own glassworks built on the outskirts of Karlovy Vary. He focused on drinkware sets for demanding clients visiting the famous spa town.

#### 1873

Ludwig presented his glass at Vienna's World Fair. He received a Medal of Merit, and Emperor Franz Joseph I awarded him an Imperial and Royal Warrant of Appointment.


#### 1900

Amongst the first to personally appreciate the quality and beauty of Moser glass was Mozaffar ad-Din Shah Qajar of Persia. This monarch and admirer of Western culture visited Karlovy Vary and the glassworks during his European travels. He awarded Ludwig Moser the title of court supplier.

#### 1908

The Moser glassworks became the court supplier of glass for England's King Edward VII.





#### LEO MOSER, VISIONARY

#### 1916

Ludwig Moser died in 1916 during WWI. His sons assumed ownership of the glassworks, with future glass designer Leo Moser at the helm.

#### 1932

Leo Moser led the glassworks for many years, creating an array of premium products that still line the annals of glassmaking history today. His work concluded in 1932 when he was forced to flee Nazi persecution during WWII. He moved to the US, where he served as an expert in glassmaking.

#### 1974

He died in New York at the age of 95.

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#### IN THE THROES OF THE 20<sup>TH</sup> CENTURY

#### 1938

During WWII, the glassworks was attributed to one of the oldest German porcelain factories: the Royal Porcelain Manufactory Berlin.

#### 1945

After the end of WWII, the glassworks became a state-owned enterprise under Czechoslovakian governance. Its production continued to uphold a high level of craftsmanship. It still focused on historically successful collections while also collaborating with young designers (Oldřich Lípa, Stanislav Libenský, Jiří Harcuba, Věra Lišková, etc.).

#### 1957

The Giant Snifters Club was founded to celebrate Moser's 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 1957. An array of distinguished personalities joined

the club over time, including American jazz legend Louis Armstrong, King of Spain Juan Carlos I, and Japanese princess Sayako.

#### 1958

Karlovy Vary crystal glass saw great success at the first significant post-war world fair, Expo 1958 in Brussels, where the glassworks won the Grand Prix award.

#### 1960-2000

Karlovy Vary crystal was then shaped by an array of artists, including Vladimír Jelínek, Luboš Metelák, František Vízner, René Roubíček, and Jiří Šuhájek.

#### **NEW HORIZONS**

#### 1991

The glassworks returned to private ownership and became a joint-stock company.

#### 2011

Moser was inducted into Comité Colbert, the prestigious association tasked with preserving and developing the handmade production of luxury goods. Thus, Moser now stands next to international brands like Chanel, Hermès, and Cartier.

#### 2011

Designer and cutter Lukáš Jabůrek won the Public Award at the Czech Grand Design Awards for the Pear vase. Pear has since become a constant Moser bestseller.

#### 2023

The uniqueness of traditionally handmade glass was also noticed by UNESCO, which added it to its List of Intangible Cultural Heritage.

#### A PULSATING BRAND

#### 2022

To extend the glassworks' historical legacy and push its aesthetics into the 21st century. With this purpose in mind, Jan Plecháč became Art Director at Moser in 2022. "Leo Moser is a great source of inspiration for me. I like to follow in his footsteps; his courage and desire to push things forward are close to me. I'm at the helm of a pulsating brand with something to say," describes Jan Plecháč.

#### 2023

Jan Plecháč was named the overall winner of the Czech Grand Design Awards, and the Moser glassworks won the Producer of the Year award under his guidance.

#### 2024

The panel of international judges at Designblok granted Jan Plecháč the highest possible award – the Grand Prix – for his Born of Sand installation.



## THE ART OF HANDMADE GLASS

Moser's works of glass demand weeks and even months of dedication from the best glassmakers, who collaborate to push the boundaries of their talents and endurance. Everything is handmade by our masters using traditional methods. Even our wooden moulds are made by hand; you won't find a single automated machine in our workshop.

This tradition of collective, handmade production is the secret to Moser's consistent quality. Be it blowing, cutting, engraving, or gold plating the glass, our success derives exclusively from the hands of the Moser glassmakers.





Moser only uses lead-free crystal, a type of glass more difficult to work with than any other. If a glassmaker wants to perfectly master the technique of working with colourless, potash-rich glass, then they can expect 10 years of arduous training. Yet, the reward for their efforts is priceless.

# BEAUTY MARKS IN MOSER CRYSTAL

Handmade Moser pieces carry an energy, feeling, and art injected into them by our master glassmakers. And so, you may have noticed that no two pieces are fully identical. Every bubble, tiny variation in material, or delicate deviation in dimensions is steadfast proof that these works are handmade.

The personalised signature of our glassmakers, engravers, cutters, and painters has


garnered admiration worldwide. Moser products adorn royal palaces, are present on tables set for noble weddings, and daily serve prominent heads of state.

We're proud of our handicraft and everything it entails. And that's because its value endures forever as an unmistakable indication of our and your unique qualities.





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#### CUTTING

The secrets of cutting glass are traditionally handed down from generation to generation. Learning to cut glass perfectly requires not only years of practice and immense talent but also the physical strength to work with pieces often weighing dozens of kilograms.

### GOLD PLATING

24-karat gold and platinum hold a prestigious position at our glassworks. The painters carefully apply the metallic solution to the crystal to create luxurious rings around the glasses, complicated images, and opulent adornments. Once fired, the metal portions are then hand-polished using precious stones: agate and haematite.

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#### GLASS ENGRAVING

At Moser, the best engravers create bold, dynamic, and aesthetically breathtaking artworks. In fact, they're the driving force behind the creation of many of the most famous works of glass in modern times. And it's only thanks to their enthusiasm that this craft, once nearly forgotten, now thrives again today.

#### GLASS PAINTING

This challenging art form used to be the most widespread type of glass décor in Europe. At Moser, we consider glass painting a royal technique, which is why we've been developing it since the glassworks' very founding. Our painters' well-crafted works ceaselessly delight new and newer generations of art enthusiasts.

Thanks to their beauty and masterful craftsmanship, the crystal gems from Moser have garnered favour from the likes of King Edward VII of England, Queen Elizabeth II and Camilla of England, Kings Haakon VII and Harald V of Norway, King Hussein I of Jordan, Emperor Akihito of Japan, Kings Alfonso XIII and Juan Carlos I of Spain, King Rama IX of Thailand, and Pope Francis.

Moser crystal drinkware sets adorned the wedding tables of King Philip VI of Spain and his wife Letizia, and King Frederik X of Denmark and his wife Mary Elizabeth. And guests of the President of the Czech Republic raise toasts with crystal glasses from Moser during state visits at Prague Castle.

Many distinguished personalities have visited the Moser glassworks to see with their own eyes how the crystal artworks are made. For instance, we've welcomed Italian actress Claudia Cardinale, the first cosmonaut Yuri Gagarin, Spanish King Juan Carlos I and his wife Sofia, Czech President Václav Havel, and Thai Princess Chulahorn Mahidol to the glassworks.

## MOSER'S KNIGHTS

Only two glassmakers from the Czech Republic have been honoured with this prestigious French designation, being dubbed Knights of the Ordre des Arts et des Lettres. And both are from the Moser glassworks. In 2020, the creator of many masterful engravings, Tomáš Lesser, became a Knight, and he was joined in 2024 by master glassmaker Zdeněk Drobný. Thus, both found themselves amongst the highest of company.

In years past, this prestigious association, operated by the French Ministry of Culture, recognised other individuals, including president and playwright Václav Havel, writer Bohumil Hrabal, and opera singer Magdalena Kožená. Foreign personalities then include the likes of actors Sean Connery and George Clooney, actresses Audrey Hepburn and Meryl Streep, singers and musicians Bono, David Bowie, and Bob Dylan, writers Ray Bradbury and Paulo Coelho, and director and screenwriter Tim Burton.

## UNIQUE MOSER COLOURS

There are six colours in the basic Moser palette: lemon-yellow eldor, light purple alexandrite, honey-gold topaz, pink rosaline, blue-green beryl, and dark blue aquamarine. Complementary colours were later added: amethyst (violet), reseda (yellow-green), pink, blue, aurora (orange), and green. Most of them are patented, and no one else on earth knows how to replicate the precise shades.

They're named after gemstones, and they're just as extraordinary. Their recipes are a strictly guarded secret; only three people in the entire glassworks know how to mix them correctly.

The glassworks can first thank Leo Moser for the development of the glass colours so typical of Moser today. His sense of technological innovation, artistic providence, and desire to create an exclusive appearance for Moser's products led him to collaborate with Berlin specialists in the field of glass staining in the 1920s. A lengthy experiment phase and countless trial smeltings resulted in special, brand-new types of molten glass, distinguished by their astonishing properties. Their colouring changes under natural or artificial light.

## NEW ERA

From his position as Art Director, Jan Plecháč has given Moser glass a new face – with modern design, non-traditional colour applications, and the courage to push the boundaries of what's possible. He does this, however, with humility and respect towards the brand's admirable and historical heritage. And his vision, dubbed Moser 2.0, is successful. He's already won multiple prestigious awards for his collections.

#### JAN PLECHÁČ

A renowned designer and the creative director of Moser. Under his leadership, the glassworks has achieved numerous successes. In addition to winning three awards at the Czech Grand Design Awards 2023 (Designer of the Year, Manufacturer of the Year, and overall winner – Grand Designer), it also received the Grand Prix and the Award for Extraordinary Achievement for the installation "Born of Sand" at Designblok 2024.

## SOFT TOUCH OF BRUTALISM

Jan Plecháč, Art Director at Moser, put his architectural studies to good use and cast his years-long fascination with brutalism into the extraordinary Magnus Collection. Its distinct lines, proportions, weight, and colouring draw from the aesthetic that principally influenced the architecture and visual culture of the 60s and 70s. It's made using the traditional underlaying technique, allowing the colours to be layered one upon the other.



## ONLY BOLD THINGS LEAVE A DEEP IMPRESSION

The aquamarine Abyss Family Collection was inspired by the ocean and free-diving. The contrast between the pressure of the depths and the meditative lightness experienced when diving is represented by the distinct brutalist cut along the outer edges and the rotund core formed by the glassmaker's breath.

And thanks to the crystal's optics, the thin layer of colour is reflected across the entire vase.

#### A TOUCH OF BEAUTY

The Dotty vase was born out of the desire to join a glossy surface with a cut, matte structure. Made of smooth crystal, the bottom part reveals the flowers' stems, while the top, cut section plays with the colours of the blossoming leaves and gentle sunlight.

The Drop vase reflects the charm of a raindrop, transforming its simple beauty into a work of art. The beryl Drop, layered with grey, captures the drop as it falls through velvety darkness. And the clear-crystal vase bears the crispness of morning dew.

In years past, glassmaking artists as renowned as František Vízner, Stanislav Libenský, and René Roubíček and Miluše Roubíčková created their own Moser designs. Many of their works are on display in both local and foreign galleries and collections.

However, their designs also adorn countless residences and home interiors. And these respected artists were later joined by the likes of Jiří Šuhájek, Rony Plesl, Lukáš Jabůrek, Jan Čtvrtník, Kateřina Doušová, Patrik Illo, and Ingrid Račková with David Suchopárek.

They're characterised by their simplified cut and more distinct use of silhouettes; they work with subtle patterns instead of ornamental decorations. Alongside clear crystal, variations of the enchanting Moser colours continue to grow in popularity.





#### LUKÁŠ JABŮREK

Glassmaker and the Art Director of Moser glassworks between 2013 and 2018.
Winner of the Public Award at the prestigious Czech Grand Design Awards 2012 for the Pear and Kolorit vase designs. His works of art for Moser glassworks are highly sought-after.

#### A BRILLIANT ATTRACTION

"A well-cut brilliant firmly holds its inclined surface. The precisely cut edges evoke an outwardly strict and exacting appearance, but inside lies a pure soul. The Pear is, at the same time, a sitting figure, a friend who will never abandon you," says the author.





The success of the Pear vase is followed by a bowl of similarly pronounced design. The confident cut of the robust crystal body is highlighted in traditional Moser colours and further enhanced by underlaid hues. Two bowl sizes in three colour combinations allow you to choose the right piece for any interior.



The ingeniously cut Caorle vase received a prestigious award for masterful craftsmanship at the 2019 Tableware International Awards of Excellence in Frankfurt. It received its well-deserved admiration not only for its precise optical cut but also its enthralling combination of green and rose hues, giving the object astonishing depth.

"My main inspiration was architecture as well as textures that can be transformed into cut décors," adds the author.

## A SCULPTURE CARVED FROM CRYSTAL

The striking Montagne vase brightens the room like an icy massif in the rising sun.

After all, it takes its name from the French word for mountain. Its distinctive cut evokes mountain peaks, while its colours conjure up the image of sunrays on icy walls.

The thick-walled design is a staple of designer Lukáš Jabůrek and fully highlights the optical properties of crystal in aurora and alexandrite shades.



## **SWEET**

**DESIGN: 2014** 

The colours of the vase and bowl from the Sweet Collection evoke memories of chewing gum, sweets, and lollipops smelling of rasp-berries and cherries.

The set's designer, Lukáš Jabůrek, recalled: "I wanted to educe the leisurely atmosphere of afternoon tea with crepes and other desserts from my grandmother. This memory is sprinkled with the sugar of fairy tales, and its aroma is captured in our crystal."

Similarly to the Planet Moser set, the Bubbles set builds on the motif of precisely cut spherical lenses. Alexandrite underlaid with any of the other unique Moser colours lends astounding airiness to the design and lets light complete the look of the piece. Despite the considerable weight of the crystal mass, the resulting shape looks as light as air bubbles rising to the surface.

This robust vase created by internationally seasoned designer Jan Čtvrtník, the recipient of prestigious awards for design, including Grand Designer and Designer of the Year awarded by the Academy of Design of the Czech Republic, is among his most popular renditions for Moser glassworks.

It stands out by its combination of helically twisted cuts and a colourful core. The refraction of light on the opposing sides of the object creates a spectacular show of viridescent gleams of beryl and reseda.

Moser engravers can bring works by Sandro Botticelli, Tintoretto, Michelangelo Buonarroti, Leonardo da Vinci, and other famous painters to glass. For the first time in 2024, they decided to try something new; they chose to engrave a select famous painting together. Creating masterful engravings takes time; clients can expect to wait six months or even two years.

Masterclass engravings have been a royal discipline at the Moser glassworks since the very beginning. Even its founder, Ludwig Moser, was an incredible engraver. Moser engravings are distinguished by their unbelievable precision and the smallest of details.




# ADD MOSER TO YOUR COLLECTION


The crystal pictures and reliefs, worked to the finest detail, are created most often from models by the most famous world artists. The repertoire of the Karlovy Vary master engravers includes Baroque chiaroscuro, more relaxed Renaissance and Classicist art, and Art Nouveau and dynamic modernism.

Thus, your collection may include crystal versions of pictures by Leonardo da Vinci, Botticelli, and Caravaggio, and also Modigliani or Salvador Dalí. A significant part of the range is the series of biblical motifs, inspired by works such as the Last Supper and the Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse.

Every motif requires weeks and sometimes even months of patient, precise work, where the engraver can't afford to make a single mistake. This requires not only talent in the visual arts and a love for glassmaking but also passion and determination to achieve what no one else can. That's why Moser engravers are considered the top of their class around the entire world.



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# THE UNION OF EARTH AND WATER

PETER PAUL RUBENS, 1618 VLASTIMIL SELINGER, TOMÁŠ LESSER, RADEK SVOBODA, 2024



The trio of amazing engravers, Vlastimil Selinger, Tomáš Lesser, and Radek Svoboda, created a masterful engraving of the painting The Union of Earth and Water by renowned Baroque painter Peter Paul Rubens. Works by these artists are present in collections by the world's most prestigious galleries. They're the result of well-considered compositions, meaning, and genius colour work, all full of dynamics and light. The oil painting THE UNION OF EARTH AND WATER depicts a scene from ancient mythology, an allegory of the two elements. The masterful engraving, a first in the history of the Moser glassworks to be created together by three engravers, adorns a hand-blown and polished crystal vase, layered with rosaline.



### THE SWING

Tomáš Lesser, awarded with the prestigious title of Knight of the Ordre des Arts et des Lettres, brought one of the most famous Rococo paintings to glass: THE SWING by French painter Jean-Honoré Fragonard. His painting style is called the Cloud Palette. And transferring such subtlety and delicacy to glass requires true mastery. The engraving adorns a vase in the colour combination of crystal and topaz.

A masterful engraving created by Tomáš Lesser, one of Moser's best engravers and bearer of the prestigious title of Knight of the Ordre des Arts et des Lettres. He brought the renowned work from the height of the Renaissance to two crystal blocks – a scene from Michelangelo's famous fresco in the Vatican's Sistine Chapel known as The Hands of God (The Creation of Adam). This unique engraving was carved into two cut crystal blocks in rosaline.

Inlaid crystal has been among the pinnacles of Moser production since the Art Nouveau period. The technologically demanding combination of an engraved floral motif across the entire surface of the piece and fused three-dimensional decoration in the shape of colourful blossoms is a technique trademarked by Moser glassworks. Works of art created using this technique were met with an enthusiastic response at the 1906 Milan International Exhibition.

Due to the difficulty of its production, the Maria Theresa set is among the most luxurious showcases of Moser craftsmanship.

The set is decorated with two different types of engraved art. The original rococo décor from 1913 is composed of ornaments of fine acanthine leafwork and flower baskets. In the 1930s, engraver Konstantin Hable Sr. expanded the set with a version featuring gallant figural motifs based on rococo paintings by J. A. Watteau.

Another prime example of how the glassmaking craft is passed on from generation to generation is the further expansion of the set by the addition of the Belvedere bowl with yet another difficult engraving, which was designed by Konstantin Hable Jr. another twenty years later.

# BAROQUE

#### CLEAR CRYSTAL BAROQUE

The Baroque drinking collection based on the designs of Arnold Zadikow from 1936 is among the most technically demanding collections in the Moser repertoire. The shape of the glasses and their rich engraved décor in particular build on patterns typical for the 18<sup>th</sup> century.

The collection is characterised by its engraved décor of dense acanthine leafwork that covers the entire shell of the chalices and reappear on the foot as well. The very architecture of the glasses, decanter or jug is similarly captivating. Zadikow also designed several vases and bowls with the same type of engraved ornament.

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### INSPIRATION FROM OUR OWN GLASSWORKS

The design of the Diplomat drinkware collection builds on the stepped-profiled vases and drinking glasses from the late 1920s, most likely designed by Leo Moser and Heinrich Hussmann. Two other designers who managed to maintain a high level of glassmaking craftsmanship in Karlovy Vary, even while under the administration of the Royal Porcelain Manufactory Berlin, were Siegmund Schütz and Gerhard Gollwitzer.

### A SUCCESS OF GIANT PROPORTIONS

This unique hexad of glasses, the shape and size of which correspond to six different human physiognomies, was created in 1957 on the occasion of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Moser glassworks. The then manager of the glassworks' Prague shop, František Chocholatý, together with his colleague Rudolf Schwedler also took the opportunity to found the Giant Snifters Club, which allows any friend of Moser luxury crystal to become a member.

The set was introduced at film festivals in Karlsbad, Monte Carlo and Sorrento. A year later, it received the Grand Prix award at EXPO 58 in Brussels as part of a broader presentation of the brand. Slim Lady, Long Fellow, Long Face, Moon Face, Stout Gentleman and Big Bertha are welcome guests in any society and know how to get things flowing.

Each glass is unique by its shape, size and the clink it makes. The glasses are also perfectly balanced, allowing them to dance on the foot. Pick the glass you find the most personable, spin it up on the edge of the foot and pour the aperitif or digestif until the glass comes to a stop. It's not as easy as it may seem...

# CRYSTAL GLOBES

Moser glassworks has traditionally made the crystal globes, i.e., the main prizes awarded at the Karlovy Vary International Film Festival. Their current model was designed by artist Tono Stano, and it features a statuette of a woman standing on her toes, holding a glass globe with outstretched arms. Its style evokes both Art Nouveau and Art Deco to match the era when cinematography was born. The statuette has become not only a symbol of

the festival but also the main heroine of its signature tunes.

We already saw everything you can do with the award in the humorous video mini-stories featuring multiple winners, including actors and directors such as Danny DeVito, Andy Garcia, Jude Law, Helen Mirren, John Malkovich, Mel Gibson, Zdeněk Svěrák, Miloš Forman, Věra Chytilová, Jiřina Bohdalová, and Jiří Menzel.

Thus, the work of Moser glassmakers has made its way into the hands of film stars and continued all across the world. For instance, a Crystal Globe was taken home by the likes of Robert Redford, Morgan Freeman, Susan Sarandon, Judi Dench, John Malkovich, and Julianne Moore.

Cooperation between the Karlovy Vary International Film Festival and the Moser glassworks comes quite naturally. Both strive for the same things: mastery, art, creativity, and spreading the good name of the Czech Republic around the world.



# **DECANTERS FOR** A QUEEN

In 2022, the Moser masters created a limited edition of 20 decanters to celebrate the 70-year reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, engraved with images of her beloved horses. The company Asprey ordered the decanters as a unique gift for the queen and her Platinum Jubilee.

#### A DECANTER WITH THE QUEEN'S DOG

In collaboration with the Moser glassworks, Asprey designed a special edition decanter for the 60th anniversary of Queen Elizabeth II's accession to the throne. Inspiration for the limited edition came from the Welsh corgi breed of dogs, which the queen had raised since she was 18 after first receiving one as a birthday gift.

Just like the preceding collection of decanters with animal-like stoppers, each piece from the corgi series is engraved with a number from 1-60.

### LA TOPAS

DESIGN: MOSER / PHILIP CHEVAL



In a traditional view, every gentleman looks good with a glass of whisky and a nice cigar. But a cigar goes hand in hand with a special ashtray. Its shape is inspired by J-class yachts, made popular by the America's Cup, the oldest regatta in the world (since 1851).

Its honey-brown colour references the topaz, a semi-precious stone also found in Czech deposits. The exclusive bespoke project was developed in collaboration between our glassworks and the German brand Philip Cheval.

## SANDS OF TIME

DESIGN: MOSER / CZAPEK & CIE

This unique hourglass was created in collaboration with a renowned Swiss manufactory. The hand-blown and cut chronometer made of clear, blue and green crystal measures a five-minute interval using grains of glass-making sand. The limited edition of only 18 pieces was introduced at the jewellery and watch fair Baselworld 2019 and sold out within a mere month.



# CRYSTAL JARS FOR THE WORLD'S MOST PRECIOUS HONEY

In 2020, the Moser glassworks created limited edition jars for the most precious Bashkir honey for Lacrima. The jars were hand-blown by Moser glassmakers, hand-cut by its cutters, and adorned with a pure gold oroplastic décor by its painters.



# LE FLACON VALENTINE

To commemorate 250 years of the prestigious brand Cognac Terrasson Comte Gerald de Montleau, Moser glassmakers created a limited edition of 250 bottles named after its founder, Valentine de Terrasson de Montleau.








# MOSER & LINLEY

# ZAHA HADID ARTWORK

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For engravers, capturing architectural forms in glass – whether historic or contemporary – is always a significant challenge. Moser engraver Radek Svoboda has masterfully rendered in crystal the work of world-renowned architect Zaha Hadid.

# ANTONÍN DVOŘÁK PRIZE

Since 2009, Moser glassmakers have made the prize for the international music event Dvořák Prague Festival. Laureates win this award for outstanding artistic accomplishments and for promoting Czech classical music. The piece was designed by architect and designer Jiří Pelcl, whose works feature in significant museums worldwide, including MoMA in New York. The prize takes the form of a violoncello – a clear reference to one of Dvořák's most famous compositions, Cello Concerto in B minor, op. 104 – presented in the cubist style.

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# MOSER AT THE ROYAL COURT







Alexandra

Moser and the British royal court has been inextricably linked since 1907 when Edward VII ordered the aptly named Royal collection.

The set was decorated with a hand-painted initial of the king and his wife Alexandra. Karlsbad glassmakers did not disappoint, and on 25th January 1908, the king awarded Moser the title of purveyor to the court.



#### SPLENDID FOR A PRINCESS

Moser continued with the "king's glass" tradition even after the war in 1947. At that time, the royal family in London received its second drinking set (after Royal) from the Karlsbad glassworks. The Splendid collection was presented by Czechoslovak president Edvard Beneš as a wedding gift to Princess Elizabeth. The set numbering 178 pieces was decorated with the E initial and the crown of the English princess. Five years later, she became the Queen.
